Wells is well known for its cathedral and Bishop's Palace, both of which have entry fees. *Currently a combined entry to both is available for £22 pp.*

We are there on a market day so it will be busy. Wells Market Place has been a focal point of the City over the ages and still is today with a twice weekly market on Wednesday and Saturday selling local produce and goods. A Farmers' Market is also held here every Wednesday.



National & local retailers, cafes and restaurants can be found around its main streets, High St, Broad St, Queen St and Market Place [above].



The Bishop's Palace and Gardens in Wells has been home to the Bishops of Bath and Wells for over 800 years and open for all to enjoy.

Adjoining the Cathedral is Vicars' Close, the only complete medieval street left in England.

The Wells Museum was founded by Herbert Balch in 1893. Balch's fine collection of local artefacts and memorabilia form the core of the museum's displays, which retains the qualities of a Victorian collection.
